The Camerloher Gymnasium Parent's Association Offers Support!

Dear Parents/Guardians

We want to ensure that all students at our school have the opportunity to participate in school trips – regardless of their financial circumstances. To prevent any family from facing insurmountable challenges, the school's support association "Elternbeirat des Camerloher Gymnasium e.V." provides funds through parental donations. These funds are intended to support families in difficult financial circumstances with the costs of school trips.

Since we have limited resources, our aim is to distribute these funds fairly and effectively to the families who need them most. However, this is only possible if all other available support options have already been exhausted. If you still have a financial gap, please contact us.

Education and Participation Act

The Education and Participation Act offers an important form of support. It allows families entitled to certain social benefits to have the costs of school trips **fully** reimbursed. We recommend that you submit the corresponding application directly to the job centre as early as possible, but no later than immediately after the participation costs are made known to you.

Children and juveniles from families receiving one of the following social benefits are entitled to benefits:

In addition, families receiving reimbursement of costs through the Education and Participation Act can apply for a pocket money allowance for school trips from the Parents' Association "Camerloher Gymnasium e.V. ".

If your family is not eligible for support from the job centre and your family income is still insufficient to cover the costs of the school trip, please do not hesitate to contact the parents' association in confidence. We are happy to assist you and will examine if and how we can offer you financial support.

How can I receive financial support from the parents' association?

To ensure that all requests are handled fairly, please note the following guidelines:

- **Basis of trust**

We trust that you will only use our support when you truly need it. Therefore, we **do not require any proof** of the information provided in your application – your **self-declaration** is usually sufficient for us.

- **Eligibility to apply**

Only the **parents** of a pupil can submit the application, even if the person in question is already of legal age.

- **Early submission**

Please ensure that you submit your application as early as possible.

- **Help with the application**

If you need help filling out the application, you can contact your class teacher, the school management, the parent representatives or us directly, which will be treated confidentially.

- **Flexibility in support**

The school's support association typically subsidises **50% of the costs** of a school trip. A **full subsidy (100%)** is only possible in exceptional cases and **requires a specific justification and supporting documentation** in the application. Alternatively, the support association may also provide you with an **interest-free loan**.

- **Your support – valuable in the future**

Should you have the opportunity at a later date, we would be grateful for a donation to the parents' association so that we can continue to support families in need.

- **Submit your application**

Please send your application to the Parents' Association – either in a sealed envelope via the school office, the class teacher or school principal, or directly by email to the association's treasurer: babsi.weinberger@gmail.com

What happens after submitting the application?

Once your application has been reviewed, we will inform you as soon as possible how much we can contribute. The approved grant will then be transferred directly to the school for the school trip.

Data protection and confidentiality

Only the chairperson and the treasurer of the parents' association are directly involved with your request, which will be treated in **strict confidence**. During an audit, the auditor may also review the records.
